


HOME ACTIVITY Ask your child to show how he or she would find 28 + 13 using an open number line.

> Place 46 on an open number line.


Count on 2 tens from 46.



4. MP.5 Use Tools Ebony has 45 beads. Ivory gives her 26 more beads. How many beads does Ebony have in all?


