Kim needs \$16 more.

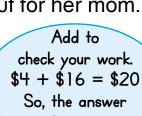


10 + 5 + 1 = 16

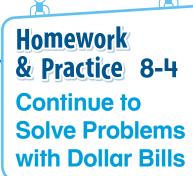
