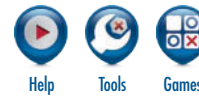

Another Look! Circle a.m. or p.m. to tell when each activity takes place.

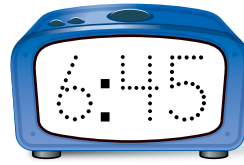
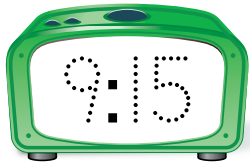
Mom goes swimming in the morning.

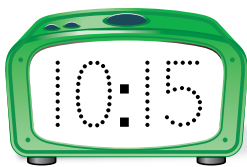

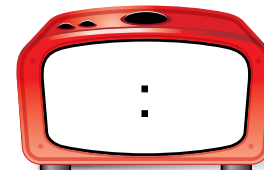
